## Restoring and Strengthening of our Democracy

- . Appointment of two Supreme Court Judges
- . Appointment of 200+ Federal Judges
- . Appointment of two Court of International Trades Judges
- . Supreme Court favorable rulings:
  - . In favor of Religious Freedom – Little Sisters of the Poor
  - . In favor of allowing the Border Wall to be Built
  - . In favor of upholding the vetting of individuals entering U.S. from countries that do not meet our security standards
  - . In favor – upholding the President’s Executive Order to eliminate enforcing a law that banned giving federal services to private schools
  - . Supreme Court Order halted the flawed Obama/Biden regulations on Clean Power Plan

## Creating a 21<sup>st</sup> Century Immigration System

- . Released a framework to fix our broken system through merit-based reform
- . Provided the resources needed to secure our border
- . Closed the legal loopholes that enable illegal immigrants, ending chain migration, and Eliminating the visa lottery
- . Secured funding to begin funding the wall
- . Deployed the military to assist in securing the southern border
- . Obtained agreement from Mexico to send 27,000 of Their soldiers to protect out Southern Border from their side
- . Required aliens seeking asylum to go to a port of entry to make their claims
- . Removed convicted criminal aliens
- . Removed known and suspected cartel/gang members
- . DOJ increased prosecution of criminal immigration offenses by 84%
- . Launched the Office of Victims of Immigration Crime Engagement (VOICE) within DHS
- . Enhance vetting of individuals entering from countries that do not meet our security

## Rebuilding America’s Military Force – “Peace through Strength”

- . Ended the devastating defense cuts of the past Administration
- . Secured investments to rebuild the military \$700 billion for FY 2018, and \$718 billion in FY 2019
- . Secured the largest military pay raise and health benefits in decades
- . Implemented new safety strategies specific to cyber security, biodefense, counterterrorism and weapons of mass destruction terrorism Elevated US Cyber Command
- . Initiated 2018 Nuclear Posture Review to improve US deterrence policy and existing capabilities to counter nuclear threats
- . WITHDREW from the one-sided no verification nuclear deal with Iran
- . Challenged European leaders to devote 2% of their GDP to NATO common defense. 26 of 27 nations increased their contribution adding 100 million to the of the western nations

- . Directed the first whole-of-government assessment of US manufacturing and defense supply chains since the Eisenhower administration
- . Empowered military commanders with broad authority to fight ISIS
- . Directed strikes in response to Assad's regime chemical weapons attacks
- . Created "Space Force" as an Independent branch of US military NASA to Expand exploration of space
- . Discontinued the use of payment to Russia for use their rockets for going into space. Instituted government and private partnerships to provide US Rockets.

### Honoring America's Commitment to our Veterans

- . Secured a record \$73.1 billion for Dept. of Veteran Affairs to provide quality medical care for veterans
- . June 2019, signed the VA Mission Act, revolutionizing the VA healthcare System. It consolidates and reforms existing programs. Provides better access to care in their communities. If a veteran can not get the care they need at the VA, they could go elsewhere and be reimbursed
- . Expanded access to Telehealth services, improved access to mental health treatment and suicide prevention services
- . Created a White House VA Hotline to provide veterans with 24/7 support
- . Signed the – "Forever GI Bill" providing veterans, service members and their families with enhanced education benefits
- . Instituted programs at the VA, Dept. of Housing and Urban Development to find permanent housing and access supportive services for veterans
- . Nov 2017, signed Executive Order 13793, to improve accountability and make it easier to dismiss VA employees who were not doing their jobs (over 8000 employees have been let go)

### Protecting Communities by Reforming our Criminal Justice System

- . DOJ announced nearly \$100 million in grant funding to hire additional law enforcement officers
- . Strongly cracked down on MS-13 gang violence. Worked with international partners to arrest and charge approximately 4000 members
- . Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) Homeland Security arrested over 800 gang members
- . Signed an EXECUTIVE ORDER to restore State and local law enforcement's Access to surplus equipment that can be used to help keep our communities safe
- . Enhanced and updated the "Project Safe Neighborhoods Program"
- . Signed legislation to IMPROVE the Federal firearms background check system and to keep guns out of hands of dangerous criminals
- . Signed the "First Step Act": it includes bipartisan reforms to make our Federal Justice system FAIRER, our communities SAFER and helps PREPARE inmates to successfully rejoin society
- . Addressed the INEQUITIES in sentencing laws that disproportionately harmed Black Americans and Reformed mandatory minimums that created unfair outcomes (90% of those benefitting from the retroactive sentencing reductions were Black Americans)
- . Provided REHABILITATIVE programs for inmates helping them successfully rejoin society and not return to crime
- . Led bipartisan effort to correct injustices to African Americans created by Bill Clinton 1994 Crime Bill and were ignored by Obama-Biden

## President takes stand against human trafficking

- . Signed the “Trafficking Victims Protection Reauthorization Act” which tightened the criteria that countries to meet standards for eliminating trafficking
- . Signed “Allow States and Victims to fight Online Sex Trafficking” – (overnight this shut down the most common websites used to sell and abuse victims in America)
- . Signed - “Frederick Douglass Trafficking Victims Prevention and Protection Act” authorizing \$430 million to fight sex and labor trafficking.
- . Signed “Abolish Human Trafficking Act” which strengthens programs, supports survivors, and provides resources for combating modern slavery
- . Signed “Traffic Victims Protection Act” that established new prevention, prosecution, and collaboration initiatives to bring human traffickers to justice
- . Executive Order - “Enforcing Federal Law with Respect to Transnational Criminal Organization and Preventing International Trafficking”, which directed The U.S. government to identify, disrupt and dismantle the transnational criminal organizations that engage in human trafficking
- . Enacted the Anti Trafficking Coordination Team (ACTeam) Initiative. The enforcement more than doubled convictions of human traffickers and increased the number of defendants charged by 75%. ICE arrested 1,588 criminals associated with Human trafficking.
- . Established Dept. of HEALTH and HUMAN TRAFFICKING HOTLINE

## Building a Stronger – Fairer Economy

\*Before COVID ——

- . More than 5 million jobs created
- . Unemployment at record low
- . Unemployment rate for African Americans lowest in years
- . Unemployment for Females -lowest in 65 years
- . Unemployment for Hispanics lowest in years
- . Manufacturing added 284,000 jobs in 2018 alone
- . \$75 Billion in private investments through “Opportunity Zones” in two years
- . After COVID – Stock Market coming back, employment coming back

## Taxes

- . December 2017, Administration passed “Tax Cut and Jobs Act” that benefitted Americans and American Companies. (More than 6 million Americans received a bonus due to tax cuts)
- . 9 in 10 Americans saw an increase in their paychecks thanks to tax cuts
- . Prior to COVID -Workers have saw the largest nominal year of wage growth in nearly a decade. (Raised American medium income 4 times (in 3 years)
- . Doubled the standard deduction for individuals and families
- . Doubled the child credit
- . Lowered America’s corporate tax rate from the highest in the developed World (allowed America’s businesses to compete and win)
- . Small businesses can now deduct 20% of their business income
- . Increased the exemption for the death tax rate to help save Family Farms and Small Businesses
- . Cut dozens of special interest tax breaks and closed loopholes for wealthy

- . Made filing taxes easier by reducing to single page and claiming the standard Deduction

## DEBT

- . Obama – Biden increased amount of US debt astronomically (\$20 trillion) has Trump was working BEFORE Covid to reduce the debt
- . Stock market was breaking records before COVID and now recovering
- . Lifted dependence on food stamps by 6.3 million people
- . Implemented tighter work requirements for food stamps. These rules apply only to able-bodied, childless adults. (Success through productive work. Work is a blessing not a punishment...)
- . Signed EXECUTIVE ORDER establishing the “National Council for the American Worker”
- . More than 185 companies and associations have signed “Pledge to America’s Workers” promising 6.4 million new training and career opportunities
- . Signed legislation that reauthorized the “Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Act” making more than \$1 billion available for career education programs
- . The Small Business Administration lent \$500 million more in Women Owned Businesses
- . Administration launched the “Women’s Entrepreneurs Finance Initiative” to leverage more than \$1 billion to support women’s entrepreneurs
- . Established 8,764 OPPORTUNITY ZONES - to spur investments in left behind Communities. \$75 Billion in long-term private capital investment in low-income and rural communities across the country that is projected to generate an additional \$100 Billion in long term private capital investments.
- . Rolled back red tape costly regulations that stifled innovation – Required to roll back two regulations for every new one in 2017 and in 2018 – roll back 12 regulations for every one
- . Rolled back regulations on small businesses
- . Streamlined permitting process for infrastructure projects with the goal of cutting approval time from up to 10 years to an average of 2 years
- . Rolled back Dodd-Frank regulations that harmed community banks
- . Negotiated new trade agreement between US, Canada and Mexico
- . Poverty rate fell to 17 year low of 11.8% as a result of jobs rich environment. Poverty for African Americans + Hispanics Americans reached their lowest levels since US began collecting such data
- . Replaced the disastrous and outdated North American Free Trade Agreement (This incentivized billions of dollars in auto and auto parts production in US and created a freer and fairer market for American agriculture)
- . Negotiated U.S.- Japan Trade Agreement
- . Established a “Trade and Investment Working Group” for negotiating trade agreement with UK
- . Authorized \$12 billion to aid farmers affected by unfair tariffs
- . American steel and aluminum jobs are coming back after tariffs to protect domestic industries vital to national security
- . Imposed crippling tariffs to force the Chinese to agree to better, fairer terms of trade. (This brought tens of Billions of dollars into the American Treasury)
- . Negotiated Phase 1 of new trade deal with China, covering intellectual property protection, and financial services.
- . China has agreed to purchase \$40-50 billion dollars in agricultural products from American farmers (2.5 times more than ever before)

## Combating the Climate Crisis and Pursuing Environmental Justice

- . Legislation passed to open up energy exploration in Alaska National Wildlife Refuge
- . Stopped Russia encroachment in Arctic area
- . Ended war on coal, cutting Obama Era regulations such as “Protection Rule” which cost industries \$81 million a year
- . Approved construction of the Dakota Access Pipeline and the cross border permit for the Keystone XL Pipeline
- . Worked to decrease energy dependence on other countries
- . Rescinded the hydraulic fracturing rule, which was expected to cost the oil and gas industry \$32 million per year
- . Curbed Obama/Biden era rule on methane, saving American energy developers hundreds of millions of dollars in regulatory costs. (More than 100 utility companies lowered their rates)
- . The U.S. withdrew from Paris Climate Agreement which harmed American workers and cost millions of jobs.
- . Signed the biggest wilderness protection and conservation bill in a decade and designated 375,000 acres as protected land
- . Signed the “Save our Seas Act” which funds \$10 million per year to clear tons of plastic and garbage from the ocean floor

## Achieving Universal Affordable Quality Health Care

- . Instituted Operation Warp Speed a private-public partnership to facilitate development, manufacturing and distribution of COVID 19 vaccines, therapeutics and diagnostics
- . Worked tirelessly to see that the States, Governors, Frontline Health Workers had the protective materials they needed.
- . Worked with private industry to produce the testing kits needed. We now are sharing with other countries as we have tested more than any in the world
- . The President wisely understood that the Governors hold the responsibility for their states and the Federal role was to support them
- . Working to provide Americans with affordable alternatives to Obamacare (TBA Sept or Oct)
- . Ended Obama-Biden era individual mandate penalty
- . Expanded short-term, limited duration health insurance plans that are 50% cheaper than unsubsidized Obamacare plans
- . Expanded Association Health Plans, allowing more employers to join across State lines and offer affordable coverage to their employees
- . Enacted “Health Reimbursed Account” regulations that will give consumers more freedom to purchase benefits that fit their needs (once finalized roughly 800,000 employers are expected to provide HRAs more than 10 million employees”
- . Signed an Executive Order allowing small businesses to group together when buying insurance to get better prices
- . Signed Executive Order requiring all healthcare providers to disclose the cost of their services so Americans can comparison shop and know what providers charge insurance companies
- . Hospitals are now required to post their standard charges for services. They must include the discounted prices for services they are willing to accept
- . Developed Medicare Advantage plans that offer more options than ever before with premiums that are lower

- . Executive Order forced all healthcare providers to disclose the cost of
- . FDA approved more affordable generic drugs
- . Administration to provide HIV drugs for free to 200k uninsured patients per year for 11 years
- . Unprecedented campaign to drive down drug prices. Negotiated recent deals with pharmaceutical companies on generic drugs to lower prices. (The U.S. was paying higher prices than other countries for the same exact drugs)
- . Signed a law ending a gag order on pharmacists that prevented them from sharing money-saving information for cheaper drugs to customers
- . Implemented reforms to the what Medicare pays hospitals for drugs (saving seniors \$320 mil)
- . Signed comprehensive childhood cancer legislation into law which will advance childhood cancer research and improve treatments
- . Signed “Right to Try” legis. expanding access to experimental treatments for the terminally ill
- . Signed “Preventing Maternal Deaths Act” that provides funding to states to better understand and focus on reducing higher mortality rates for Black Americans

### Combating Opioid Crisis

- . Signed SUPPORT for “Stop Opioid Abuse and Reduce Drug Supply and Demand” The largest legislative package to address a single drug crisis
- . Secured a record \$6 billion in funding to fight the opioid crisis
- . Administration provided more than \$2 billion in grants to help States, Territories, Tribes and local Communities to prevent and treat opioid abuse
- . Launched a nationwide public awareness campaign about dangers of opioid addiction and youth usage – declared a nationwide Public Health Emergency
- . Secured first-ever indictments against Chinese nationals for fentanyl trafficking
- . DOJ formed a “Joint Criminal Opioid Darknet Enforcement team” – (Shut down biggest distributor of drugs)
- . Launched A Safer Prescribing Plan to cut nationwide opioid prescription fills by 1/3 in three years

### Standing up for Sanctity of Life and Protecting Religious Liberty

- . “Protect Life Rule “– prohibits Title X family planning funds from going to any clinic that performs on-site abortions. Planned Parenthood announced they would be leaving the Title X program
- . First President to address the March for Life
- . Reinstated and expanded the Mexico City Policy that blocks \$9 billion in aid from funding abortion internationally
- . Defunded a United Nations agency for colluding with China’s brutal program of forced abortion and sterilization
- . Administration withdrew guidance that constrained a State’s ability to exclude Family Planning Providers that provide abortion services from the Medicaid Program
- . Administration formed a new “Conscience and Religious Freedom Division” to protect religious freedom
- . Expressed strong support for the “Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act” which would stop abortions after 20 weeks
- . Administration proposed regulations to ensure Title X family planning funding does not go to projects that perform, support or refer patients for abortions

- . Issued an Executive Order to promote free speech and religious liberty. (This helped faith-based groups give healthcare coverage to 13.7 million Americans)
- . Administration issued regulations establishing new or expanded exemptions from the Obamacare contraceptive mandate based on religious beliefs or moral convictions

### Achieving a World Class Education in every Zip Code K-12

- . Reduced regulations from the US Dept. of Education to return power to the States and Local Governments
- . Trump directed the Secretary of Education to end Common Core
- . Supported school choice to ensure all students have a fair chance for quality Education and provide parents with choices
- . The tax cuts that were signed into law promote school choice by allowing families to use 529 college savings plans for elementary and secondary education to schools they choose
- . Rescinded Obama/Biden era policy that called on schools to have more lenient policies for racial minorities than white students

### Higher Education

- . December 2019 signed a bipartisan bill that would restore \$250 million to Historical Black Colleges and Universities.
- . Signed legislation to increase HBCUs federal funding by 14%
- . Made HBCUs a priority by creating the position of executive director of the White House Initiative on HBCU's
- . Received the "Bipartisan Justice Award" at a historically black college for criminal justice reform accomplishments
- . Cancelled Obama/Biden era guidance on the unfair practice of not allowing student accused of sexual assault the right to fairly defend themselves. The new rule expanded due process for accused.
- . Rescinded, July 2018, Obama/Biden rule on student loan forgiveness, which had a wide definition of "fraud" and replaced it with a rule that an adopted a definition common in a court of law
- . Executive Order - to protect campus free speech rights by denying federal research funding to universities that do not protect free speech
- . December 2019, executive order to withhold federal funds from universities that do not combat anti-Semitism

### Renewing American Leadership

- . Brokered a landmark peace deal between Israel and United Arab Emirates
- . Revoked Obama's executive order that lifted the sanctions and sent suitcases of CASH to Iran and also allowed a terrorist nation into the community of nations without any reforms. He ignored the mullah chants of "Death to America". Spoke out against the fact that Iran sold 150,000 rockets to Hezbollah
- . Criticized strongly the Obama/Biden signed deal that gave Iran a path to NUCLEAR weapons without adequate inspections

- . The administration held an historic summit with Chairman Kim Jong-Un to begin peace and denuclearization talks to the Korean Peninsula
- . The remains of POW/MIA service members were returned to US
- . President secured passage of historic sanctions on North Korea
- . Followed through on promise by recognizing Jerusalem as the capital of Israel and moved the US embassy there
- . Withdrew the US from the UN Human Rights Council due to its bias against Israel
- . Made clear it does not accept the international Criminal Court's jurisdiction over Americans and to protect American sovereignty
- . President has advocated for cutting waste at UN – cut millions of dollars
- . Administration encouraged members in NATO to increase their defense spending, pay their fair share and realign the Alliances priorities
- . Administration worked to advance a free, open Indo-Pacific via investments and partnerships
- . Enacted tough sanctions on corrupt regimes in Venezuela, Cuba, and Nicaragua
- . Supported enhanced support for Ukraine's defense
- . Signed the "Iraq and Syria Genocide Relief and Accountability Bill" which assured that U.S. aid to the Middle East would ACTUALLY reach Christians and other religious minorities
- . 2018, signed the Hezbollah International Financing prevention amendments. It imposed sanctions not only on Hezbollah but also those found to cooperate with the terrorist organization
- . In 2018, the US withheld \$255 million of military aid to Pakistan and suspended \$900 million in security assistance as they continued to support terrorism
- . The Trump administration made it a priority to take on ISIS and the leader Abu Baker al Baghdadi in the Iraqi war. In Oct. 2019 he was hunted down and killed in Syria
- . Killed Major General Qasem Soleimani in the Iranian Revolutionary Guard who reigned terror through the Middle East
- . Launched a TV Network "Current Time" to counter Russian Propaganda Administration
- . Implemented the "Global Magnitsky Human Rights Accountability Act which blacklisted Russians who violated human rights
- . August 2019, withdrew from the "Intermediate Range Nuclear Forces Treaty" due to Russia's and China's repeated and persistent violations of the pact. (Both were violating the ban on immediate range missiles)
- . In 2017, the U.S. ended funding for the UN population fund that had links to China's policy of restricting its citizens to one child
- . December 2017, pulled out of the Global Compact on Migration, a UN agreement that infringed on US sovereignty and its immigration policies
- . August, 2018 Trump announced permanently defunding of UN "Relief and Works Agency" as the money was earmarked for refugee Camps in Pakistan where terrorists were being trained
  - . 2018, cut \$200 million in aid to Palestinian because of their unwillingness to engage in peace talks with Israel and their sponsorship of terrorism
  - . March 2018, US voted against UN resolution demanding Israel withdraw from Golan Heights
  - . Administration is unambiguous in support for Israel (One of our greatest Allies)
  - . Administration issued tariff threats that forced Mexico to crack down on Illegal immigration. (Mexico for the first time is enforcing its own Immigration laws.)
  - . Administration sent thousands of National Guard forces to southern border to stop the caravans of Central American migrants entering the U.S.

. Administration is backing Taiwan. US opened a new de facto embassy in Taiwan who is resisting China Imperialism. Approved \$330 million sale of arms to Taiwan. (To put a stop to Chinese forces harassment)
